

WCMCA Head Start Program Report For Period Ending December 2011

Education Services:

- ✓ We are at full enrollment of 265 children and have 87 children on our waiting list.
- ✓ Staff have completed 11,149 observations on enrolled children to date.
- ✓ Staff have completed 566 home visits with children and families.
- ✓ Average daily attendance for the month was 90%.

Health Services:

- ✓ 96% of children have completed a social-emotional screening.
- ✓ 96% of developmental exams have been completed.
- ✓ 79% of dental exams have been completed.
- ✓ 96% of the children have completed hearing exams.
- ✓ 97% of the children have completed their physical exams.
- ✓ 96% of the children have completed their vision exams.

Family Services:

- ✓ We have had 223 families complete their family needs assessment with 85% of families entering into family partnership agreements and setting goals as a result.
- ✓ Staff distributed 50 informational items (newsletter articles, flyers or brochures) to families during the month.
- ✓ Staff referred 92 families to other WCMCA programs.

Disabilities Services:

- ✓ We have 69 children (26%) diagnosed with disabilities and on Individual Education Plans through their local school district. Of these children:
 - 38 have a Developmental Disability
 - 29 have a Speech or Language Impairment
 - 1 is Severely Multiply Impaired
 - 1 has a Health Impairment
